RESEARCH DIRECTIONS

Section 1. Innovations and new approaches to the transformation of professional military education.

Innovative approaches to transforming professional military education aim to enhance the learning process through conceptual renewal, digital solutions, new technologies, blended formats, and instructor development. The research highlights innovation under limited resources and constant threats, focusing on digitalization, updated curricula, and quality assurance. Special attention is given to adapting education to modern security challenges and strengthening PME to meet the needs of the defense sector amid the full-scale Russian aggression against Ukraine.

Section 2. Implementation of the experience of the Russo-Ukrainian war into the training content for specialists within the system of professional military education.

Actualization of PME content based on the Russo-Ukrainian war involves transforming programs, integrating combat experience into courses, and preparing specialists for modern warfare and complex security situations. The focus is on reflecting war lessons in curricula, creating relevant modules, and adapting approaches to the dynamics of combat. Particular attention is given to effective mechanisms for transferring combat experience, aligning education with the needs of the Armed Forces and the security sector, and improving training under wartime conditions.

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION IN THE CONFERENCE:

1. The International Scientific and Practical Conference invites participation from academic and scientific staff, adjuncts, and doctoral candidates of higher military educational institutions of Ukraine and partner countries, as well as representatives of the military command bodies of the Ministry of Defence of Ukraine, the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine, and other components of the security and defense sector.

2. Applications for participation in the conference and abstracts of reports are accepted until **October 27, 2025**.

3. Abstracts of reports must be prepared in accordance with the following requirements:
electronic version in Word format (doc/docx);

the file name must correspond to the surname of the first author in Latin script, e.g., Tkachenko.doc.

4. The structure of the report text should include the following elements:

relevance of the problem under consideration, its relation to the current state of the security environment, as well as the novelty and reliability of the presented results;

formulation of the problem in general terms and its relation to important scientific or practical tasks faced by the security and defense sector;

analysis of recent research and publications on the relevant topic;

statement of the purpose of the report (problem definition);

presentation of the main material with justification of the obtained results;

conclusions and prospects for further research in the specified area.

Regulations for Presentations at the International Scientific and Practical Conference:

Reports – up to 15 minutes;

Speeches – up to 10 minutes;

Statements – up to 3 minutes.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE FORMAT OF ABSTRACTS OF REPORTS:

1. The Organizing Committee is not responsible for the content of the submitted materials. Authors bear personal responsibility for the presence in their materials of restricted information, in particular that which constitutes a state secret.

2. The volume of the report materials must not exceed 5 full pages. The text must be prepared in Microsoft Word, font Times New Roman, size 14, line spacing 1.5, style – Normal, without hyphenation. Paper format – A4.

3. Page parameters:

margins: left – 2.0 cm, right – 2.0 cm, top – 2.0 cm, bottom – 2.0 cm; pages without numbering.

4. In the upper right corner of the first page (without indents, in regular font, without italics or underlining):

military rank, surname and initials of the authors; academic degree and academic title (if available).

5. The title is printed in uppercase letters, bold font, without italics or underlining, centered on the page, without hyphenation. The title must be separated by one blank line above and below.

6. Formulas, figures, tables, and the list of references may be included at the discretion of the authors.

Proceedings of the conference are planned to be published as a collection of abstracts.
